



STANDARD LEGAL DEFINITIONS

January 2026

The following definitions are deemed incorporated in RegenMed legal documents.

Account	The account specific to a Circle Member, including the roles, permissions, Team Members, payment mechanisms, Funder, and other attributes associated with such account.
Affiliates	The Company, its owners, subsidiaries, affiliated companies, officers, and directors.
Answer	A single Datapoint resulting from an entry against a Survey Question.
Attributes	Anatomical region, pathology, diagnosis, treatment protocol, patient outcomes assessments, medical codes (ICD, LOINC, CPT, SNOMED, etc.), and other clinical/scientific characteristics prospectively or retroactively assigned to an Observational Protocol, and inherited by Cases generated pursuant to that OP.
Authorized Amendment	A document executed by the Company and a Funder amending a Master Services Agreement or Statement of Work.
Authorized Personal Data Recipient	An individual or entity authorized through a Consent to maintain or review, solely for the purposes specified in such Consent, the Personal Data of a consenting Data Subject.
Authorized Representative	The person(s) identified in a Master Services Agreement as authorized to agree to Authorized Amendments.
Case	The integrated longitudinal record comprising all Datapoints entered against an Observational Protocol for a single Data Subject.
Circle	The healthcare professionals and patients entering data into Cases.

Circle Datasets	Datasets derived from one or more Circles based on one or more Attributes and/or Answers.
Circle Health Coin	The blockchain-enabled cryptographic representation of all accumulating Datapoints in a single Case.
Circle Member	A healthcare professional generating, or assisting in the generation of, Cases.
Circle Platform	The patented inCytes™ Benchmarc™ platforms, and related processes and services.
Company	RegenMed, Inc. a corporation formed and operating under the laws of the State of Delaware, U.S.A., and/or Regen Med Europe SLU, a limited liability company formed and operating under the laws of Spain, with its registered office at C/ Muntaner, 200, Primera Planta 08036 Barcelona, España.
Company Intellectual Property	The Company’s rights to and ownership of the Circles Platform and all associated content, functionality, materials, issued patents, patent applications, trade secrets, Circles Datasets, and other proprietary elements of or generated through the Circles Platform.
Confidential Information	Any information, not already legitimately in the public domain, which is proprietary to the Company, a Funder, an Investigator, or other Person involved in a Circle, and which has been designated by such Person as confidential, including through a confidentiality or non-disclosure agreement.
Consent	A written communication in which a Data Subject has explicitly consented to send, receive and/or maintain Personal Data through or in connection with the Circles Platform or Company websites.
Customization Information	Any information, photographs, professional biographies, Patient Report templates, Patient Communication templates or other material or information provided by the Licensee for use on or in connection with the Circles Platform.

Datapoint	A single, discrete Answer to any Question contained in an Observational Protocol.
Data Controller	The meaning attributed to it in GDPR Article IV .
Data Processor	The meaning attributed to it in GDPR Article IV .
Data Sub-Processor	The meaning attributed to it in paragraphs 2 and 4 of Article 28 of the GDPR.
Data Subject	The meaning attributed to it in GDPR Article IV .
Funder	A Person responsible for payment of one or more Products and Services Charges.
GDPR	The European General Data Protection Regulation .
HIPAA	The U.S. Health Insurance Portability and Privacy Act of 1996 .
License	This document, as amended from time to time and published here .
Log-In Credentials	An e-mail address, password, verification code(s), Circle Coin key, and other forms of identification specific to each Circle Member.
Master Services Agreement	The Agreement specifying the general legal rights and obligations of the Company and a Funder, and with respect to which one or more Statements of Work are issued.
Observational Protocol	An integrated set of Surveys designed to generate a statistically and clinically significant Circles Dataset for a specific set of Attributes.
Payment Terms	The terms pursuant to which a Funder is liable for payment of Products and Services Charges. Payment Terms can be found here .
Person	An individual or legal entity.

Personal Data	Any data or information specific to an individual considered by HIPAA, GDPR or other applicable law, regulations, or the policies to be private or otherwise subject to protection, non-disclosure and/or privacy.
